To guide your prayers during this fortnight...

- ◆ Pray for all the communities in Indonesia still recovering from the tsunami. Pray for strength, perseverance and provision as they rebuild their lives.
- ◆ Pray for a time of rest and refreshment for families at the start of the school holidays.
- ◆ Pray that you will be 'moved' with God's kind of compassion.
- ◆ With the conflict continuing to intensify over the last few months in north-western Syria, pray for protection over civilians & for peace across the whole country. Give thanks that, in other parts of Syria, people are beginning to return to their home communities to rebuild their lives.
- ◆ In the same way our loving Father has restored His relationship with you, ask Him to help you to restore any broken relationships in your life.
- ◆ Pray for the people of South Sudan, especially those who have fled their homes and are struggling to survive. Pray for lasting peace in the country, and that weapons of war will be replaced with arms to embrace one another.
- ◆ Ask God to help you to love others as He loves you.
- ◆ Pray that social media firms take seriously their responsibility to protect children and young people from viewing unsuitable content online.
